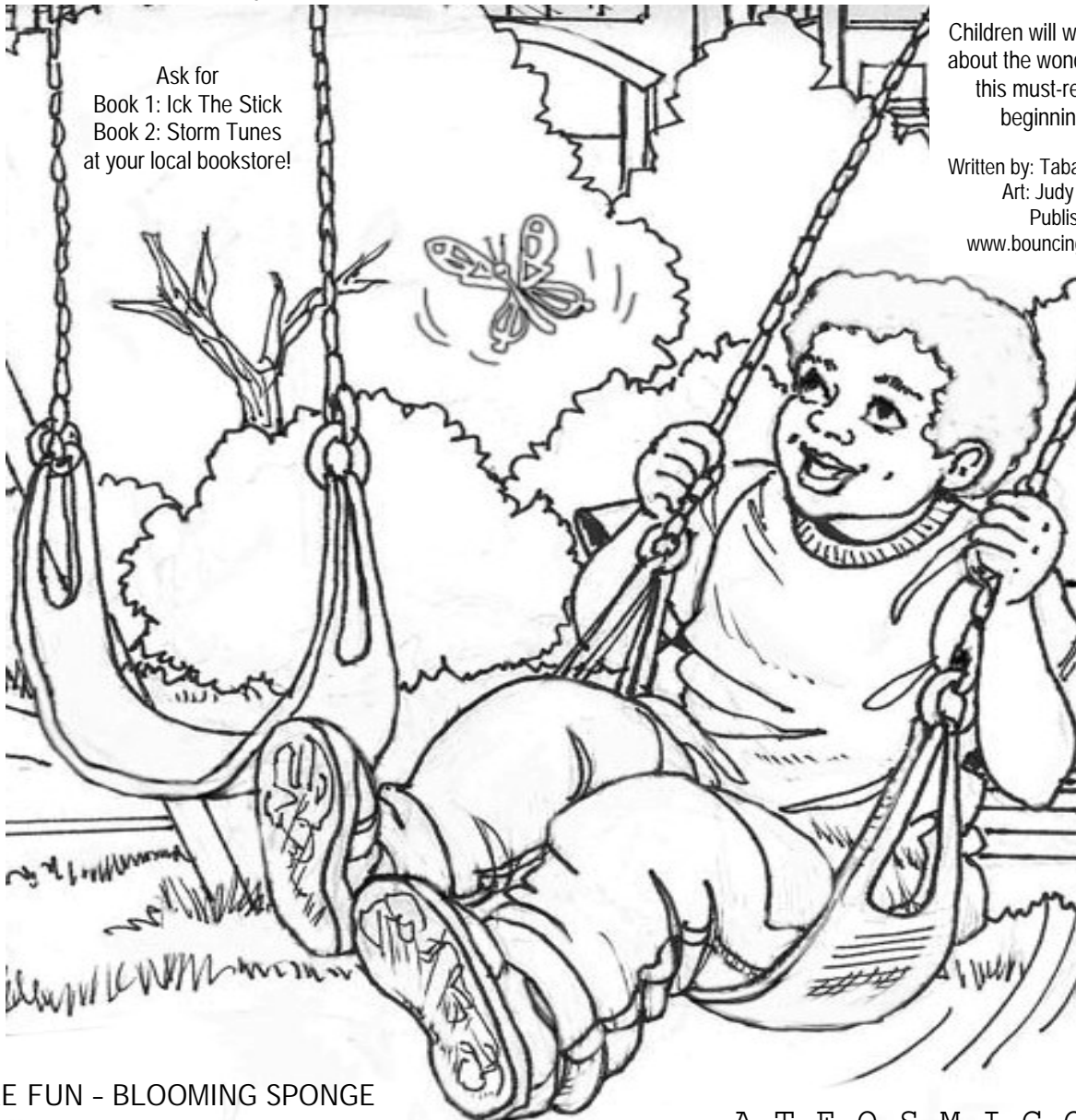

NATURE FUN - BLOOMING SPONGE

Have you ever wondered what might happen if you planted a handful of birdseed? Well, wonder no more! Now you can have some nature fun while you witness a variety of growths on a single sponge!

What You Need:

- * 1/2 cup of (any) wild birdseed
- * 1 sponge (any size)
- * 1/4 cup of water
- * small plate
- * plastic wrap

Directions:

1. Place sponge on small plate
2. Dampen sponge with water (Do not soak!)
3. Completely cover top of sponge with birdseed
4. Cover loosely with plastic wrap

*Keep your sponge on a windowsill and water lightly every other day. Within a few days, you'll start to see sprouts and you'll have your very own blooming sponge!
